We are currently looking for two qualified, energetic individuals to fill the following positions:

### Camp Counselor/Theatre Mentor (8 weeks)

#### Who We Are:

Windsor Light Music Theatre (WLMT) is a local community theatre organization that strives to produce high quality, Broadway-style musical theatre performances for the enjoyment of audiences in Windsor and surrounding areas. This year, we are celebrating our 76<sup>th</sup> year of quality theatrical programming. In addition to our performances, WLMT offers a thriving collection of arts-education programs for our youth members.

### **Job Description:**

The Camp Counselors will work for a period of 8 weeks as they organize and facilitate all elements of WLMT's Drama Camp and Teen Theatre Showcase programs. These individuals will work together to create a dynamic camp curriculum, and will collaborate to implement the curriculum during each camp session using fun, innovated strategies. They will also be tasked with arranging daily lesson plans, compiling administrative and education resources, and participating actively in all camp sessions. All the while, they will be responsible for supervising, managing, and mentoring groups of youth participants ranging in age from 8-17. They may also be responsible for independently delivering music and/or movement workshops as assigned by the program directors.

# **Availability:**

Camp Counselors must be available Monday and Friday between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm from July 2, 2024 to August 23, 2024. Specific work hours will be scheduled at a later date. While most of this time will be spent facilitating the programs, designated time for orientation, training, and planning will also be provided.

### **Requirements:**

Qualified applicants must have relevant theatre experience as well as experience working with youth in an artistic or educational environment. Post-secondary training in dramatic arts, music, education, or a related field, is an asset. The successful applicants must be self-directed, creative, motivated, and have excellent rapport with children/teens. These positions are made possible through funding from the Canada Summer Jobs Program. Applicants must be between the ages of 18 and 30 and legally able to work in Canada.
