




AUDITION NOTICE - A CHRISTMAS CAROL THE MUSICAL (FALL 2022)

Auditions will be held starting May 26th 2022 by appointment only. Rehearsals will be held on Monday and Thursday evenings from 7:00 PM - 10:00 PM, June 2022 - November 2022 with a summer break.

Initial auditions will focus on singing. Please prepare the audition cut(s) listed below for the character you are auditioning for. If you are auditioning for more than one character, you may be asked to sing each characters' audition cut. You may be invited to a callback and/or a dance call which may include some line reading and more singing.

All auditions will take place at the Windsor Light Music Theatre Rehearsal Hall, located at 2491 Jos St. Louis Ave., Windsor, Ontario.

Character Descriptions and Audition Songs

A Christmas Carol is set in Victorian England in the city of London. All characters will be required to speak with an English accent. All ages listed are suggested stage ages.

LEADS

Ebenezer Scrooge

A man who lost his father to creditors as a kid and has grown up heeding his father's advice to save his money. Until he realizes how terrible he's become, he is grumpy, unsympathetic man and has no time for anyone or anything.

Gender: Male

Age: 45 to 65

Vocal range: A2 – G4

Audition Song - Nothing to do With Me Part 6 (measure 324 - 358)

Lamplighter / Ghost Of Christmas Past

An ever cheerful, sprightly ghost who comes back with the history book of Scrooge's past to show him the events that led to his current state. Actor doubles as Lamplighter.

Gender: Male or Female

Age: 20 to 60

Vocal range top: G4/G5

Vocal range bottom: A2/A3

Audition Song - The Lights of Long Ago (measure 33 - end)

Sandwich Board Man / Ghost Of Christmas Present

A jovial, larger-than-life ghost who comes back to show Scrooge all the joy, love, and celebration he is missing out on while those around him celebrate Christmas. Actor doubles as Sandwich board Man.

Gender: Male

Age: 35 to 45

Vocal range top: A2 – G4

Audition Song - Abundance and Charity (measure 165 - 181)

Blind Old Hag / Ghost Of Christmas Future

A beautiful, and terrifying wrath, the Ghost of Christmas Future is strong and silent as she shows Scrooge what will happen to him and those around him if he continues down the path he is currently treading.

Gender: Female

Age: 50 to 65

Vocal range: A3 – D5

Bob Cratchit

A father and husband who cares deeply for his family, particularly his youngest son. He works hard to provide for them but is mistreated by his employer, Scrooge.

Gender: Male

Age: 30 to 40

Vocal range: A2 – E4

Audition Song - You Mean More To Me (measure 141 - 162)

Tiny Tim

Mr. and Mrs. Cratchit's youngest son. He is physically disabled and sick, but is the definition of loving Christmas spirit. He constantly reminds his family that as long as they all have each other, they will be happy.

Gender: Male

Age: 8 to 10

Vocal range: A3 – E5

FEATURED ROLES (may double as ensemble)**Mrs. Cratchit**

Tiny Tim's mother and Mr. Cratchit's wife. She is a loving mother who tries to provide the best for her children with what she's got.

Gender: Female

Age: 30 to 40

Vocal range: A3 – E5

Audition Song - Christmas Together (measure 104 - 135) please sing both Mr. and Mrs. Cratchit parts

Fred Anderson

Scrooge's nephew and only living relative. He is a pleasant young man who believes in the good a joyful Christmas spirit can make in the world.

Gender: Male

Age: 25 to 35

Vocal range: A2 – F4

Audition Song - Christmas Together (measure 416 - 452) Please sing all Fred/Sally/Kid parts

Ghost of Jacob Marley

Scrooge's former business partner who, before his death, was exactly like Scrooge. Comes back as a ghost in chains to warn Scrooge of how his life decisions will bind him in the afterlife.

Gender: Male

Age: 45 to 55

Vocal range: A2 – A4

Audition Song - Link by Link (measure 1 - 34)

Scrooge's Mother

Scrooge's mother as he remembers her from his childhood.

Gender: Female

Age: 35-45

Vocal range: C4 - C5

Audition Song - Old Bailey (God Bless Us Everyone) (measure 21-34)

Child Scrooge

Scrooge at 10 years old.

Gender: Male

Age: 10 to 12

Vocal range: F#3 - A4

Audition Song - A Place Called Home Part 1 (measure 40 - 64)

Young Scrooge

Scrooge in his early 20s. He falls in love with Emily but becomes too focused on money.

Gender: Male

Age: 18 to 25

Vocal range: A2 – G4

Audition Song - A Place Called Home (measure 17 - 57)

Emily

Scrooge's fiancé from when they were young. She is a beautiful girl, not impressed or in need of money.

Gender: Female

Age: 18 to 25

Vocal range: A3 – G5

Mrs. Fezziwig

The consummate hostess and Mr. Fezziwig's wife, she loved to help throw the Christmas party every year. She is prideful.

Gender: Female

Age: 50 to 60

Vocal range: A3 – A5

Audition Song - Mr Fezziwig's Annual Christmas Ball (measure 17 - 37)

Mr. Fezziwig

A portly, jolly man who used to throw a huge Christmas party every year for the community. He was Scrooge's first boss and after teaching him all he knew, he became deeply disappointed in the man Scrooge became.

Gender: Male

Age: 55 to 65

Vocal range: A2 – B4

Audition Song - Mr Fezziwig's Annual Christmas Ball (measure 17 - 37)

Fan

Scrooge's sister as she would have been during his childhood.

Gender: Female,

Age: 12

Vocal Range: F#3 - E5

Audition Song - A Place Called Home part 1 (sing both Scrooge and Fan parts measure 40-64)

Grace Smythe

The daughter of one of Scrooge's clients. Her mother has recently passed away and her father owes Scrooge money.

Gender: Female

Age: 10

Vocal Range: D4 - D5

Audition Song - Nothing to do With Me (measure 298-312)

ADULT ENSEMBLE

Approximately 10 women and 10 men. We are looking for a variety of singers and dancers age 14+.

*We are seeking at least one performer with tumbling/acro skills. There are several featured roles within the ensemble.

- A Beadle (male, age 40+) - solo speaking and singing
- Three Charity Men (male, any age) - trio singing
- Mr. Smythe (male, age 30+) - solo speaking and singing
- Mrs. Mops (female, age 50+) - solo speaking and singing

- Sally Anderson (female, 25-35) - solo speaking and singing
