WHO WE ARE

Founded by Dr. John Watson in 1948 as the Windsor Light Opera Association, in our first year we presented *The Pirates of Penzance* with 43 cast members on stage. In the early years, we produced what was, at the time, referred to as operettas or “light operas”, which reflected in the name. Since that time, musicals have changed and so has our name. In 2007, Windsor Light Opera Association became Windsor Light Music Theatre (WLMT) to better encompass the shows being produced but still keeping the “Light” aspect of the shows being chosen and performed by the group. Today WLMT continues to produce two full scale Broadway musical productions every year as well as a Youth Theatre production.

WLMT is a member-based, non-profit organization whose tireless volunteers come from all walks of life. Year after year their hard work and dedication make it possible to fully realize these Broadway shows for the enjoyment of Windsor and surrounding area audiences. As a part of Essex County’s cultural industry, Windsor Light Music Theatre provides a creative outlet for our diverse and multi-generational community; we are proud to be the amateur beginning to many professional level careers.

Ruby is very excited to be a part of this show, as it is her first Windsor Light production. Ruby enjoys spending her time singing, acting and

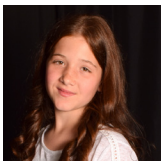

Brian is so excited to be back on stage with Windsor Light. Past credits include King Triton in Disney's The Little Mermaid, Peter in

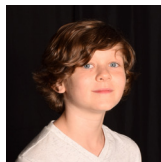

Easton is a grade 9 student at Sandwich Secondary. He is passionate about performing on stage, especially in musical theatre.

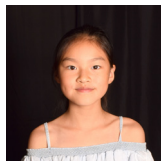

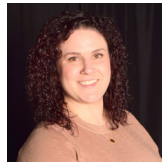

Andy is a life member of WLMT who has appeared onstage in more than 30 productions. He is looking forward to visiting Austria

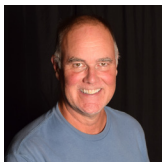
