## CHARACTER DESCRIPTIONS

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## Narrator/Jean Shepherd: Non-Singing Role; Audition: A Christmas Story

Male, playing 40-60's, any ethnicity

The actual Jean Shepherd is the author of the books that this story is based on, as well as the voice of the narrator in the 1983 film. He is a warm, charismatic, and engaging storyteller. An omniscient, good-natured curmudgeon with a deadpan sense of humor. Jean focuses the action, keeps the story moving, and holds the audience's attention with his presence and spark. This is a non-singing role.

Ralphie Parker: Vocal range: F#3 to D5; Audition: Ralphie to the Rescue, Red Ryder Carbine Action BB Gun, Somewhere Hovering Over Indiana

Male, playing 9-12, any ethnicity

He is a bright, winsome, mischievous, and cute kid. The type that you wouldn't mind having as a neighbour. Ralphie's imagination tends to run wild at times as he dreams of the Red Ryder Carbine Action BB Gun he desires for Christmas.

The Old Man: Vocal range: B > 2 to G4; Audition: A Major Award

Male, playing age 30 - 40, any ethnicity

Ralphie's father is a gruff and grumbly individual. However, inside he has a good heart and love for his family. More than willing to wear his frustrations on his sleeves, he is not above reveling in a little showmanship.

**Mother**: Vocal range: G3 to D ♭ 5; Audition: What a Mother Does, Just Like That Female, playing 30 - 40, any ethnicity

Ralphie's mother is the force that keeps the household together. She keeps a calm exterior despite the struggles that are thrown her way constantly by her husband and two children. Vibrant, warm, and affable, but she is no pushover.

**Randy**: Vocal range: F#3 to D5; Audition: Somewhere Hovering Over Indiana Male, playing 8 - 9, any ethnicity

Ralphie's younger brother. He is cute, cuddly, and lovable, but also whiny. He revels in being the baby of the family to his advantage. He looks up to his brother despite not seeing eye to eye with him at times

**Miss Shields**: Vocal range: F#3 to D5; Audition: You'll Shoot Your Eye Out Female, playing 30 - 50, any ethnicity

Ralphie's 5th grade teacher, a stereotypical 1940s educator. She is prim, proper, stern when necessary, though warm and even humorous when the situation merits it. Must be able to tap dance or be willing to learn.

Santa: Vocal range: B ♭ 2 to F4 ; Audition: Up On Santa's Lap

Male, playing 30 - 60, any ethnicity

The Santa Claus at Higbee's Department Store is ill-tempered, slightly inebriated and very unhappy with his job--nothing like the "Jolly Old Elf" of the Christmas stories.

**Scut Farkus**: Audition: When You're a Wimp, To The Nightclub

Male, playing 12 - 15, any ethnicity

This truant is one year or two older than Ralphie and is a textbook example of a schoolyard bully. Scut is loud, obnoxious and intimidating.

Grover Dill: Audition: When You're a Wimp, To The Nightclub

Male, playing 10 - 12, any ethnicity

Grover is Farkus's toady and is always at his side. Younger and smaller than Farkus, Grover idolizes Farkus and delights assisting him with his dastardly deeds.

Child Ensemble: Audition: Sticky Situation, When You're a Wimp

Playing 9 - 12

The Kids' Ensemble is heavily featured throughout the show. This group contains various classmates and supporting parts. Including but not limited to: *Flick, Schwartz, Mary Beth, Nancy, and Esther Jane*.

**Adult Ensemble**: Audition: A Christmas Story

Mix of strong vocalists and/or dancers

In addition to the kids' ensemble, the adult ensemble will play a major role in bringing this show to life. We are seeking a diverse group to fill out the various side characters, elves, and townspeople that populated 1940s small town Indiana.

Pit Chorus: Audition: A Christmas Story

A strong mix of vocalists to help create a balanced and full sound under our stage.

## **AUDITION DETAILS**

**SINGING & ACTING:** Adults auditioning for a singing and/or an acting role must book ONE (solo) 5-minute audition. Singing and acting will be together in this timeslot. Children must attend the children audition day on June 1, time to determined at a later date. **SONG PREPARATION:** Leads, ensemble and pit chorus. Upon a completed registration form is confirmed production will email a google drive page to view audition material for the role(s) you marked off. Come prepared but you may only be asked to sing for one role. **ACTING PREPARATION:** At the initial audition you may be given a side to sight read. Callbacks will all be required to participate in vocal and acting exercises. **DANCE PREPARATION:** Dance auditions will take place on May 23 with a brief production introduction prior to the audition portion of the night. TAP: If you have a pair of tap shoes please bring them and be prepared to showcase your abilities at the dance call. **ENSEMBLE CASTING:** A dance troupe will be cast from the ensemble. All who wish to audition for the ensemble must complete a dance and/or movement audition. **ADDITIONAL CASTING OPPORTUNITIES:** Any role may be double cast OR understudied at the discretion of the

production and casting panel.

## **AUDITION DETAILS (CONT.)**

There will be a few marketing events that

all cast will be required to attend.

Dancers, please bring character, jazz WHAT TO WEAR: and/or tap shoes. All should come prepared and warmed up and ready to move. **AUDITION PHOTOGRAPHS:** ALL candidates consent to having their photo being taken upon arrival for the casting purposes. You may bring a headshot. **AUDITION REGISTRATION:** https://forms.gle/oYj3DYJTW6142Bq36 NO PERSON can audition without completing this registration form. **CALLBACKS:** If the creative team feels that you are a fit for a role that matches their casting concept and vision, you may be asked to attend the callback date. Sides may be given out in advance or cold reads given on the night of. Callbacks will be in a group setting to mix and match potential actors. If you are not given a callback, do not fret! We are searching for a diverse and specific cast to bring this show to life. There will be cameos and supporting roles cast from the selected ensemble members. **WLMT MEMBERSHIP:** All cast and crew or others directly involved in the production must become a member. Fees can be paid in the first month of rehearsals. Participation cannot continue to occur with an outstanding account in Jan. \$40 Youth Member - Annually \$50 Adult Member - Annually Let us know if you have any concerns. **CAST COMMITMENT:** Check your availability to commit to all dates for rehearsal and performances.
