### DIRECTOR

### **Primary Responsibilities:**

The Youth Performance Program Director will be the artistic director of WLMT's 2025-2026 youth production. They will plan weekly rehearsals and lead the youth participants in various games and dramatic activities throughout the course of the production. They will collaborate with a Music Director and Choreographer to develop a creative vision for the show, as well as provide direction to several technical department heads in areas such as set design, wardrobe design, paint, props, lighting, sound and more, with the end goal of producing a quality performance. Additional responsibilities may include, but are not limited to, parent communication, budget tracking, backstage work, etc.

#### Availability:

Rehearsal responsibilities will be Saturdays from 9:00 am – approximately 1:00 pm, with additional meetings, planning sessions, and other requirements as needed. The program runs from September to April, with administrative duties beginning in August.

#### **Requirements:**

Qualified applicants must have extensive theatre experience, as well as a wide range of experiences working with youth (ages 10-16). Applicants with education in areas relating to music, dance, performing arts, education, and who have a strong love of theatre would be an asset. Successful experience directing youth theatre is also an asset. The successful candidate must be self-directed, creative, motivated, and must enjoy working with young learners with diverse needs and levels of experience. All applicants must be 18 years of age or older.
